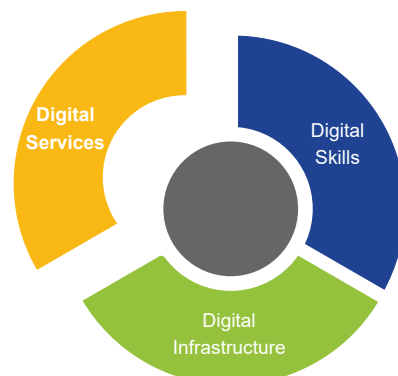

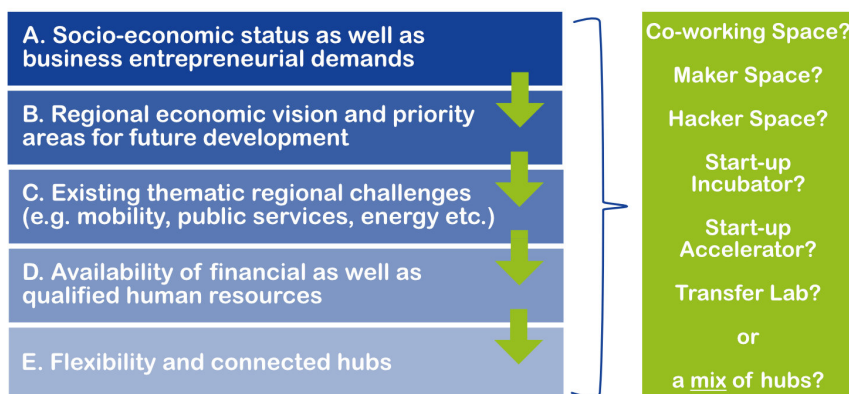
IN A NUTSHELL
